#### CSA needs volunteers in the following areas:

- Driver to deliver food to seniors: volunteers are needed to deliver groceries to seniors Tuesday or Thursday between 9 am-11 am. All deliveries are in the Mountain View, Los Altos, and Los Altos Hills and will take between 1-2 hours. This opportunity is a sixmonth commitment and requires a background check.
- Driver to pick up donations: volunteer drivers are needed Monday, Tuesday, and Friday from 9 am Noon to pick up food donations. Volunteers must be at least 21 years of age, lift at least 30lbs with repetition, and be comfortable driving a cargo van. This opportunity is a six-month commitment and requires a background check.
- <u>Mountain View Senior Center:</u> volunteers will help at the Mountain View Senior Center Thursday's 10:30 am-12:30 pm. This opportunity consists of signing in seniors who will be picking up their lunches and passing out the lunches. This opportunity is a six-month commitment and requires a background check.
- Pantry: volunteers helping in our food pantry are limited due to space constraints because of social distancing. The pantry tasks will vary depending on the day. Based on needs volunteers will distribution preparation by packing food bags, off-loading deliveries, receiving donations, and helping with distribution by serving clients. Some lifting is involved. All volunteer shifts are Monday-Friday between the hours of 9 am-5:30 pm.
